ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrive Mombasa- Transit to Tsavo East National Park

Start your safari with a visit to Tsavo East National Park, enter the park via the Bachuma gate (appr. 100km out of Mombasa), game-drive enroute to the lodge/camp. Tsavo East is one of the largest and oldest parks in Kenya. Its separated from Tsavo West by the highway and railway. Great to spot lots of wildlife of which the park has an abundance. The Yatta Plateau, Lugard Falls, Galana River are some of the known features of Tsavo East. Lunch at the camp/ lodge - afternoon game- drive.

Wake up for an early morning game-drive, the best time to view wildlife! A big variety of wildlife can be spotted in the plains and swamps, Giraffe, zebra, Cheetah, Lions, Buffalo and many more. Lunch at the lodge/camp afternoon game-drive.

1. The Role of Ocean Tribe

It is important that you read our terms and conditions, once we have received your payments, its assumed that you have read and understood our terms and conditions.

2. Prices
